Mi'kmaw Nation asserting treaty right to a self-regulated moderate livelihood fishery after the Marshall decision.

Why it matters

The 1999 Marshall decision affirmed Mi'kmaw treaty rights to fish for a moderate livelihood. Sipekne'katik launched a self-regulated fishery when federal negotiations stalled — facing violence and legal pressure from commercial fishers and DFO.
